

District Goal---To meet students where they are, enhance their academic performance, support their social-emotional well-being, and ensure they are safe.

- Implementation of Renaissance, Freckle, Nearpod, and DnA
 - Identifying students' academic gaps and needs (STAR)
 - Provide differentiated, personalized learning experiences (Freckle).
 - Enhance engagement and real-time interaction during lessons (Nearpod).
 - Gain detailed insights into student progress and tailor instruction to meet standards (DnA).
- Focus on Tier 1 (Core) Instruction
 - Ensuring that standards are being taught at the level the standard was written
 - Professional Development throughout the year (Continuous Improvement Directors, CKEC, KEDC, KCM, content specific PD)
 - Curriculum Work
 - Use and Purchasing High Quality Instructional Resources
- Intervention Plan Analyzed at Each Level
 - Developed a criteria for students to enter Tier 2 and 3
 - Below the 24th percentile Tier 2 on STAR
 - Below the 10th percentile Tier 3 on STAR
 - Tier 2 and 3 students have been identified through the universal screener, KSA, other assessments, and classroom performance
 - Use of Lalilo, Freckle, Nearpod, ALEKS, and CBMs
- Initiating the Portrait of a Learner in all schools
- Added 3 ELL teachers to our district to support our ELL students.

District Goal---To meet students where they are, enhance their academic performance, support their social-emotional well-being, and ensure they are safe.

- All schools have counselors to support students' social-emotional well-being.
 - o Counselors at all elementary schools with 1 counselor who travels to each elementary school.
 - o 2 counselors at the middle school, and 3 counselors at the high school
 - Social Emotional Lessons are being taught at all schools: Character Strong,
- Social-Emotional Support
 - Provide individual and group counseling, crisis intervention, social skill development
 - Trusted Adult Surveys--assigning mentors to students based on this survey
 - Bloomsights--social emotional wellbeing screener
 - This provides data as to which kids need to be seen immediately and provides data on students who need
 individual and group counseling
 - Identifies students who need Tier 3 services with outside partners
- Academic Support
 - Providing guidance and planning
 - Monitoring Progress and meeting with students who are at-risk of failing
 - Advocate for Students: removing barriers to learning by working closely with teachers, parents and administrators.
- College/Career Exploration (mainly at the 8th grade to HS level)
 - o Individual Learning Plans--Xello Program
 - Transition classes from 8th grade to the HS
 - Meeting with students concerning their interests and developing a plan for their HS pathways and courses.
 - o Organizing College and Career Fairs
 - Uniting all stakeholders to promote college and career readiness/exploration
 - AP classes and Dual Credit Courses are offered--counselors help students determine which courses are best for them
- Behavior Management
 - Behavioral Interventions
 - Promoting a Positive Environment at each school

District Goal---To meet students where they are, enhance their academic performance, support their social-emotional well-being, and ensure they are safe.

- School Safety
 - Audio Enhancement has been placed in all of our schools to improve safety within our schools
 - New card entry into all schools
 - Schools are implementing security protocols with controlled entry points, visitor sign-ins, and staff monitoring to prevent unauthorized access. Security cameras and locked doors further enhance safety.
 - School Resource Officers visible at our schools and monitoring our school safety
 - Construction has begun to enclose the Annex Building to the Middle School and installing fencing around the middle school to ensure safety for our students
 - Schools regularly conduct emergency drills, including fire drills, lockdowns, and evacuation procedures, to prepare students and staff for different crisis scenarios.
 - Proper maintenance of schools: We conduct regular inspections to ensure that playgrounds, buildings, and equipment are safe and comply with safety standards.
 - Communication System Improved with our local police department and emergency services along with all stakeholders
 - Anti-bullying Programs have been implemented (through our counseling department)
 - Cyber and Digital Safety (promoted through our technology department)
 - Providing health care through our school nurses and Sterling Health
