

Early Childhood Learning

- On October 18th and 25th our preschoolers were able to experience a wonderful day at Neltner Farm. It was a great parent engagement opportunity, and they enjoyed picking pumpkins in a real pumpkin patch.
- Kindergarten screening report (see attached)
 - Of the 28 students ready, 24 went to public preschool, 2 Head Start, and 2 In child care facilities.
 - 17/55 have IEP's, 31%
 - Strengths noted in the area of language.
 - 77% average or above average In language skills.
 - 49% average or above average in social emotional skills.
 - 40% average or above average in physical/fine and gross motor skills.
 - 33% average or above average in cognitive/concepts. Letter recognition was weakest area. Math and number sense a strength.
