- Events/Activities for Parents – 32.72%

What do you think the school could do better to involve you in your child's education?

- Communication – 14.44%
- Skilled/Caring Teachers & Staff – 7.35%
- Following the IEP – 8.99%
- Events/Activities for Parents – 10.41%
