
TERM OF OFFICE TO BEGIN October 21, 2024

I, Sarah Rohrer, do solemnly swear or affirm that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and be faithful and true to the Commonwealth of Kentucky so long as I continue to be a citizen thereof, and I will faithfully execute, to the best of my ability, the office of school board member of the Berea Board of Education according to Law; and I do further solemnly swear of affirm that since the adoption of the present Constitution, I, Sarah Rohrer, being a citizen of this state, have not fought a duel with deadly weapons within the state nor out of it, nor have I sent or accepted a challenge to fight a duel with deadly weapons, nor have I acted as a second in carrying a challenge; nor aided or assisted any person thus offending, so help me God. (Kentucky Constitution Section 228)

I, Sarah Rohrer, being first duly sworn, state that I am eligible under the law to serve as a member of the Berea Board of Education, and that I will not, while serving as a member of such board, become interested, directly or indirectly, in any contract with or claim against the board, and that I will not in any way influence the hiring or appointment of district employees, except the hiring of the superintendent of schools or school board attorney. (KRS 160.170)

**160.170 Oath of board members.**

Every person elected to a board of education shall, before assuming the duties of the office, take the following oath, in addition to the constitutional oath:

"State of Kentucky,

"County of Madison

"Sarah Rohrer, being duly sworn, says that he or she is eligible under the law to serve as a member of the board of education, and that he or she will, while serving as a member of such board, carry out all duties prescribed by law and remain eligible for membership on the board of education.

The oath shall be kept on record by the board.


