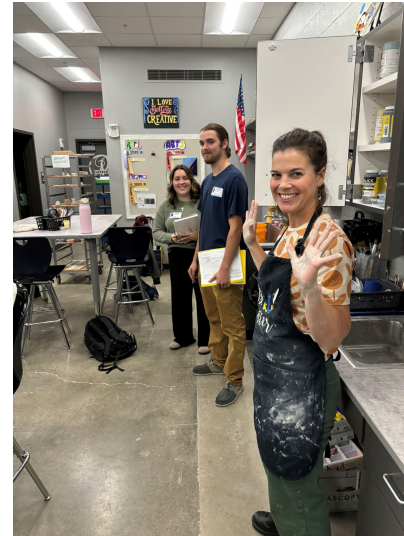
Kentucky Agriculture Commissioner Jonathan Shell spoke to students at Marion County High School this morning.
