**Recommendation/Motion:** Approve the proposed additive Change Order No. Two to the contract with Momentum Construction, LLC for the construction of three preschool classrooms and HVAC replacement at Harrison Elementary School in the amount of \$51,460.14 (Fifty-thousand, Four Hundred Sixty Dollars and Fourteen Cents), with an equivalent transfer of funds from Object Code 0840 to 0450 and a corresponding transfer of \$2,526.97 (Two Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-six Dollars and Ninety-seven Cents) for design consultant fees from Object Code 0840 to 0346.

**Background/Rationale:** In the spring of 2022, the Board designated funding to support the FCPS Preschool program based upon a five-year plan. A priority of that five-year plan includes adding preschool classrooms at Harrison Elementary School. The Preschool program staff recommended that three preschool classrooms be constructed to serve 45 children in a full-day program. Ross Tarrant Architects produced final Construction Documents for bidding describing the new construction and HVAC replacement. A bid was received on January 30, 2024, and construction began in May 2024. The Office of Facility Design & Construction, the design consultants and the local building code officials have reviewed the progress of the work. Changes to the original plans and specifications have been necessary in order to satisfy the requirements described below. Approval of these changes allows the work to be completed. The description and cost of these items are summarized as follows:
