NFHS Middle School Committee

The Committee met October 14-15 in Indianapolis and I currently serve as committee chair. The Committee continues to work towards providing resources for middle school athletics across the country. The NFHS MS Committee was given a review of the current state of officials across the country. We also heard updates from NFHSLearn, performing arts, and emergency action plans. The committee was divided into three sub-committees to review the position statement drafts. The following are the position statements being developed:

- Similarities and Differences between Middle School and High School

The Committee also finalized goals and initiatives for the 2024-25 school year which includes:

- Add a middle school category to NFHS awards program (starting with the Performing Arts).
- Develop mental health resources and share materials created by SMAC and the Learning Center.
- Collaborate with the Learning Center to create and produce the Parent Seat Video.
- Emphasize an "all-out awareness" campaign with all entities to highlight the middle level by attending state conferences, national conventions and establishing relationships with organizations.
