# Franklin-Simpson Channel 9 FSEEF Application

Franklin-Simpson Channel 9, the official local access channel for Simpson County Schools, has been a cornerstone of the Franklin-Simpson community for over 30 years. Established to bring school and community events directly to the public, FS Channel Continues to provide an essential service by live-streaming and recording athletic and community events. These broadcasts allow alumni and community members near and fai to stay connected. This program offers unique value to the community, fostering engagement and pride among Simpson County Schools' supporters worldwide.

#### What is Franklin-Simpson Channel 9?

Franklin-Simpson Channel 9 captures a wide range of sports, community, and school events for Simpson County Schools. Below is a list detailing some of the key programs that FS Channel 9 covers throughout the year:

- Home and away football games
- Home and away basketball games
- Home soccer games
- Home volleyball games
- Home baseball games
- Home softball games
- Community plays and musicals
- School board meetings
- Fiscal court meetings
- Concerts on the Square

#### Challenges

Currently, the Franklin-Simpson Channel 9 team must reserve one of the district vans to transport students and equipment to each game or event. When a van isn't available, the ability to transport our crew and equipment is disrupted, often resulting in lower-quality production or, at times, preventing us from broadcasting entirely. As shown in the image below, the FS Channel 9 crew is often forced to set up in the stands to live-stream games. Once transportation is covered, other challenges persist: many schools lack the necessary space and resources for our student broadcast crew. This setup proves to be a challenge to maintain operation due to the high value of the equipment, extensive setup of cords and cables, and potential weather issues. To effectively address these critical challenges, sufficient funding is essential to enhance student expertise and expand production capabilities.




#### **Proposal**

The solution to these problems is to purchase a Ford Transit van. Funding for this project will allow us to create a mobile production space for the FS Channel 9 crew. A broadcast van like the one in the image below will allow Franklin-Simpson Channel 9 to set up more easily and efficiently. The ability to park the van directly near the press box, gym, or event spaces we film will provide invaluable efficiencies, allowing more time for instruction, training, and post-production work. With all equipment centralized in the van, we can eliminate the need-for multiple cable setups, enabling seamless media transmission through a single cable. This van will open new possibilities for expanded education, career readiness, and media production, serving as an enduring asset to our community for years to come.







#### **Community Involvement**

Franklin-Simpson Channel 9 proudly partners with eight community sponsors who help bring FSHS Athletics to fans worldwide. Current sponsors supporting Channel 9's vision include Franklin Bank & Trust, All-Starz Dance Academy, Trent Bedding, Wilkins Eye Care, among others. These sponsors receive reciprocal benefits for their financial support through advertisement placements during our broadcasts, enhancing their visibility and community

Franklin-Simpson Channel 9 is excited to invest in a used Ford Transit Cargo Van to enhance our program's capabilities. A quality used Ford Transit Van, with reasonable mileage, is estimated to cost approximately \$25,000. Additionally, building out the necessary fiber network infrastructure for the van will require an investment of around \$25,000, bringing the total project cost to approximately \$50,000. We respectfully request support from the FSEEF to help fund this pivotal advancement for our program. We are also seeking additional support from the Simpson County School Board and local business sponsors to invest in our students and the community through this initiative. The van will feature a branded FS Channel 9 graphic, along with the logos of supporting businesses and individuals who partner with us. We would be honored to display the FSEEF logo prominently on the back or sides of the van, pending final design and wrap capabilities.

#### **Implementation**

Implementation of this project will commence as soon as possible, with an estimated completion timeline of one month, once all materials are ordered and prepared for installation. With the basketball season approaching in early December, the goal is to have the project finalized by that time. With the right resources, we're eager to take FS Channel 9 to new heights, offering a more seamless and professional experience for both our students and viewers!






