


#### Q1 Please select your child's grade



### Q3 Please rate your child's overall experience as a student athlete this season




### Q4 Please rate your overall experiences as a parent of a student athlete this season








### Q6 The head coach creates an atmosphere of respect & develops positive relationships with athletes
