

Special Education and Preschool Board Report, November 2024

- 1. The December 1 Count is quickly approaching! I have been reviewing files and running error reports to be prepared for the 2024 December 1 Count.
  - Purpose of the Count: The December 1 child count is essential for ensuring states receive appropriate federal funding to support special education services. It provides a snapshot of the number of children with disabilities receiving services under IDEA.



- 2. The Fall Alternate Assessment Window for Kentucky begins on November 12<sup>th</sup> and ends on December 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - Mr. Lucas and Mrs. Gosney are prepared to administer the Kentucky Alternate Assessment. We currently have 4 students on Alternate Assessment.
  - The Kentucky Alternate Assessment was developed in 1990 as a result of the Reform Act of 1990 to provide schools and programs with a valid and reliable means of assessing the instruction provided to students with moderate and significant disabilities (i.e., for the less than 1% of the total student population for whom traditional assessments would be an inappropriate measure of progress).



- 3. Preschool will be hosting their next Parents Club on November 12th at 6pm.
  - The monthly parent club provides the opportunity for preschool staff and parents to share information, ask questions, and learn more about all the great things happening in the Preschool Classroom.
  - Mrs. Scott sent out a survey to parents asking the best time for meetings.
    The response was equally divided between 3:15pm and 6:00pm, so the meetings will alternate month by month to allow all parents the opportunity to participate.
