

# New Regulation 704 KAR 3:315 Certification of Nonpublic Schools

## **Background**

- KRS 156.160 provides that nonpublic schools may voluntarily comply with the guidelines established by the KBE and be certified by the board.
- Since 1992, the KBE has collaborated with the Kentucky Non-Public Schools Commission (KNPSC) to complete the voluntary certification process.
- The KBE issues voluntary certifications annually at the June board meeting.



#### **Section One – Definitions**

• "Nonpublic school" means any private, parochial, home-based, or church school. A public charter school as defined by KRS 160.1592 is not a nonpublic school.

#### **Section Two - Procedures for Certification**

- 1. The nonpublic school must seek accreditation from an approved accreditor.
- 2. The nonpublic school must apply for voluntary certification through the KNPSC.
- 3. The KNPSC annually produces a list of nonpublic schools for consideration by the KBE.
- 4. Upon the recommendation of the KNPSC, the KBE may revoke certification at any point during the school year.



# **Section Three - KNPSC Required Policies**

- 1. KNPSC shall adopt a policy for the screening and selection of eligible accrediting agencies.
- KNPSC shall adopt a policy for recommending nonpublic schools to the KBE for certification.
- 3. KNSPC shall adopt a policy for recommending certification revocation.
- 4. The KDE shall provide technical assistance as requested by the KNPSC.
- The KNPSC shall annually submit the three required policies to the KBE for review and approval.



# Section Four - Posting Requirements

- 1. The KNPSC and KDE shall post on their websites a list of certified nonpublic schools that includes:
  - a) The name of the certified nonpublic school,
  - b) The public school district in which the nonpublic school is physically located,
  - c) The grade levels served,
  - d) The physical address,
  - e) The telephone number,
  - f) A static email address,
  - g) The school's website URL, and
  - h) The expiration date for the nonpublic school's voluntary certification.



### Section Four, Continued

- 2. The KNPSC and KDE shall post on their websites a list of approved accrediting agencies.
- 3. The KNPSC and KDE shall post on their websites the three required policies.
