<b>Bowen Elementary</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Peer observations started this month to support teachers in developing instructionally. Kindergarten was paired with 1st, 2nd paired with 3rd grade, and 4th grade paired with 5th grade. Peer observations will take place each month.</li><li>• Continued focus on implementation of curriculums including reading, math, social studies, and science (newly added for grades 3-5). Continued monitoring through building walkthroughs and classroom observations.</li></ul>
