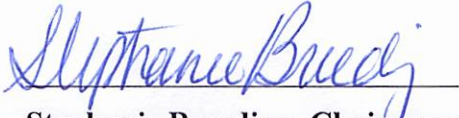

- K. D. Willcox and M. Dorsett both haven't heard anything from parents that need to be discussed.

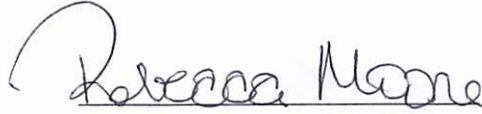
XI. ADJOURNMENT
