

Parent Involvement Report

December 12, 2024

As a result of various events to begin the 2024 school year including Parent Teacher Conferences conducted in October, the schools reported the following participation:

Franklin Elementary - has had many opportunities to include family and community in their learning this year. In September at our Grandparents event, we had **234** grandparents/guests attend. The Fall Festival had **167** people to attend. Parent/Teacher conferences had a total of **262** parent contacts made. In November, Thanksgiving Family Lunch will anticipate around 100 family members visiting FES to eat with their students. Overall, FES has had an increase in family and community involvement at **663** total. That increase is starting to have an impact.

Simpson Elementary- had **2,025** parents involved since the beginning of school with **577** Parent Teacher conferences, Fall Festival with **330** family members, and **32** for Veterans Day participating. A record number **1,086** attended for the grandparent breakfast which is AMAZING!

Lincoln Elementary-had **915** parent/guardians participate in school events since the beginning of school. **402** total Parent Teacher conferences were conducted which is an increase from the previous year. Grandparents breakfast **383** attended and **130** at the Fall Festival.

Franklin-Simpson Middle School- had a total of **335** parent contacts for Parent Teacher conferences as well as each month they have a student of the month ceremony where the parents are invited to attend. They anticipate conducting a parent night soon. The ICU program is another way the middle school reaches out to parents and guardians.

Franklin-Simpson High School-had a total of **292** Parent Teacher Conferences. Parent contact has been added to Weekly Overviews.

Franklin Simpson-West Campus- had a total of **24** virtual and in-person students represented in conferences.

Total Parents Involved= 4,122 This is an increase of **869** parent contacts from this same time last year. That is tremendous! Almost doubled last year's increase! We have seen more interest in coming to school and actively participating in school events. As a district, we are making an intentional effort to find ways to involve more parents. We realize that engaging ALL stakeholders, especially our parents, will increase student achievement.
