Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to approve 215 bus monitors and bus drivers to 8 hours a day from 6 hours a day.

Background/Rationale: Currently there are 263 Bus Drivers and 186 Bus Monitors listed (scheduled) in ERP/MUNIS at six hours per day (Total = 449) and there are 12 Bus Drivers and 11 Bus Monitors listed in ERP/MUNIS at eight hours per day. Of the 449 employees; 125 Bus Drivers and 70 Bus Monitors are scheduled to work 8 hours per day to cover mid-day runs, trips, etc. Upon review by staff, we would like to move 215 of the 449 positions to 8 hour positions to assist in recruitment and retention, cover overscheduled hours, match leave to work obligations and mitigate overtime.
