

**Special Education and Preschool Board Report** 

## December 2024

- 1. The December 1 Count has been completed, submitted, and verified. We currently have 42 students receiving Special Education, an increase from 39 on last year's count.
  - a. The December 1 count is the official count for students being served under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA)
  - b. The count includes all students 3-21 who have active IEPs on December 1 each school year.
  - c. The count is used for calculation of Exceptional Child Add-On to SEEK Funding for the following school year.



2. Mr. Lucas has been working on administering the Fall Alternate Assessment. We currently have 3 students who qualify for alternate assessment. The Fall testing window opened on November 12<sup>th</sup> and ends on December 18, 2024. All testing will be completed by then. There is a 2<sup>nd</sup> testing window in the spring, which runs from April 14<sup>th</sup> – May 23<sup>rd</sup>.



3. Preschool's Pies with Parents event in November was a huge success! The Preschool Team does an amazing job of providing engagement opportunities for our parents/caregivers. We love having our families in the building, and so do the students!
