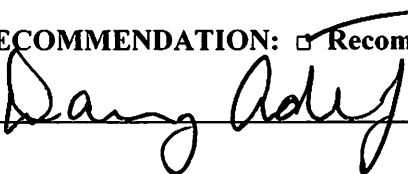

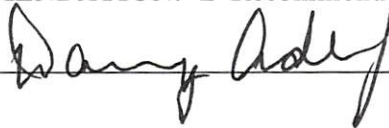

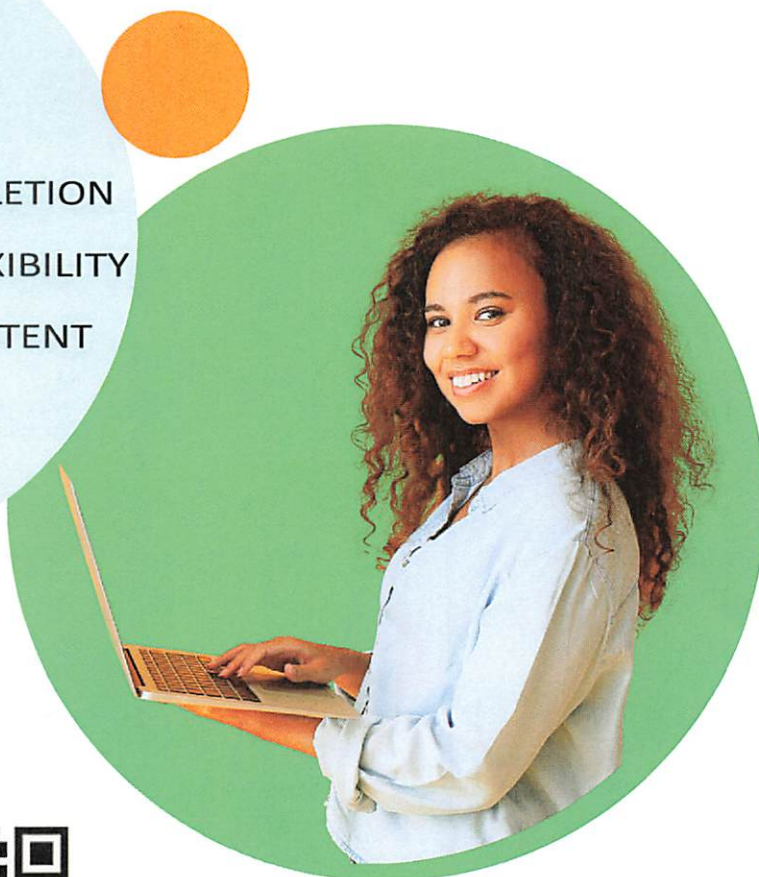

in Kentucky's schools, focusing on key areas that support students with disabilities. Educators selected to participate in this program are eligible for a \$750 stipend upon successful completion. Tier I program is self-paced and features a dynamic asynchronous

online learning experience. Eligible applicants include General and Special Education Teachers, Counselors, Job Coaches/Employment Specialists, CTE Teachers, school and district administrators.
