MUNICIPAL ORDER 38-2024

A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION FOR AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT THROUGH FEMA IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$129,915.16, THE PROCEEDS OF WHICH WILL BE UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO UPGRADE ENGINE 2 AND ENGINE 4 TO ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNITS; A TEN PERCENT (10%) MATCH IS REQUIRED BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Owensboro Fire Department (OFD) desires to complete the buildout of its Advanced Life Support (ALS) Program and upgrade Engine 2 and Engine 4 to ALS units; and

WHEREAS, in order to do so, OFD needs to purchase two (2) LifePak 35 monitors and additional tools; and

WHEREAS, the Owensboro Fire Department seeks to file an application for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant through FEMA in the approximate amount of \$129,915.16, the proceeds of which will be utilized by the City of Owensboro to purchase the necessary equipment and tools; and

WHEREAS, a ten percent (10%) match is required for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a grant application to be filed for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant through FEMA in the approximate amount of \$129,915.16, the proceeds of which will be utilized by the City of Owensboro to purchase two LifePak 35 monitors and other tools needed

to upgrade Engine 2 and Engine 4 to ALS units, for which a ten percent (10%) match shall be required from the City.

Section 2. That the Mayor, City Manager and appropriate staff members are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all other agreements, instruments or documents necessary and appropriate to effectuate and implement any grants awarded to the City.
