


Rethinking Education



Board of Education Support:

- In 2024, the JCPS Board of Education solidified this work as an essential focus in the district through the Goals and Guardrails.
- As a result, the JCPS Academic
 Readiness Measures were developed
 as a local accountability model that
 values both traditional academic
 indicators and success skills.
- Journey to Success is the formalized system to support this shift in our schools. It provides guidance to schools and expectations for creating the learning environment




