CSIP:

Our goal is to continue the amazing growth that GES has experienced over the past couple of years. To that end, the following areas are our focus:

- Increase students scoring proficient/ distinguished in math and reading by at least 10% over the next year
- Decrease the percentage of students who are economically disadvantaged scoring in the novice range by 10%.
 - Teachers will continue to work with our State Literacy Coach, Allison Roth, on lesson internalization and effective instructional practices.
 - Developing and using learning targets with success criteria during instruction for student and teacher clarity and using formative assessments to determine mastery of the standard.
 - Increased focus on using the data we collect in order to build instructional plans for students during W.I.N. time (What I Need), and using our HQIR (high quality instructional resource) for extension and remediation to ensure effective instruction.
 - Refining PBIS and SEB practices to increase positive behaviors, decrease behavior referrals, and increase school attendance.
