

Support Education Excellence in Kentucky (SEEK) is the foundation program for legislative funding of public education and provides a per pupil amount of funding based on the average daily membership in conjunction with average daily attendance in grades K- 12. Virtual and performance-based attendance funding is derived from the percentage of scheduled courses with passing grades each semester.

The Kentucky Department of Education will be hosting SEEK training at each of the educational cooperatives. *The event at NKCES is scheduled for February 19, 2025 from 9:30 to 12:30 and is open to the public. Registration is not required.*

Attendance

Attendance month 4 closed on December 13, 2024. One day delay is noted due to school cancelation on Thursday, December 5, 2024. Each school month will be adjusted to reflect this change and attendance month 4 data will be reported at the January Board meeting. Schools have through December 20, 2024 to balance month 4 attendance.

Required Reporting School Report Card

The Kentucky Department of Education has communicated that they hope to have a public soft launch of the School Report Card beginning the week of December 16, 2024. This information was communicated through a Special SRCC/DAC email on December 10, 2024. Known issues continue to be addressed by the current third-party vendor. School Report Cards for each school and district will be published to our website when they are available to us.

Continuous Improvement Planning

Each school in the district has updated their Comprehensive School Improvement Plan. Schools are in year 3 of a 3-year plan. The district plan is entering into year 2 of implementation. At the district level, each department is reporting their aims and drivers, progress monitoring, and evidence of implementation through scheduled cabinet meetings. Progress monitoring of CDIP implementation and level of implementation are monitored through department work and upload to a shared drive for Leadership review.

Declaration of Participation

On an annual basis KDE requires each public-school district to obtain a completed declaration form from each private, non-profit school and home school physically located within its geographic boundaries. The data is reported to KDE through the Grant Management Application System and is utilized to assist with the allocation of federal funds. This data is also used by Newport Independent to assist with determining services to be provided to private, non-profit and home schools electing to participate in the federal programs. At this time, Newport Central Catholic has declared an intent to participate in Title II.
