Staff Success



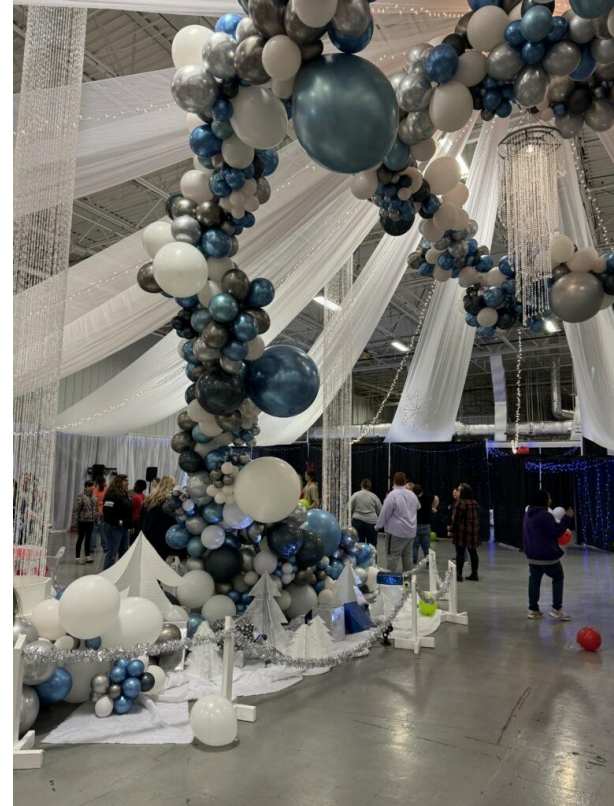
Congratulations to Director of Student Support/SEL Coordinator Veronica Deacon who recently completed her Ph.D. in Leadership through the University of the Cumberland.

Members of the MCHS JROTC program helped place wreaths at the Lebanon National Cemetery for Wreaths Across America Day.



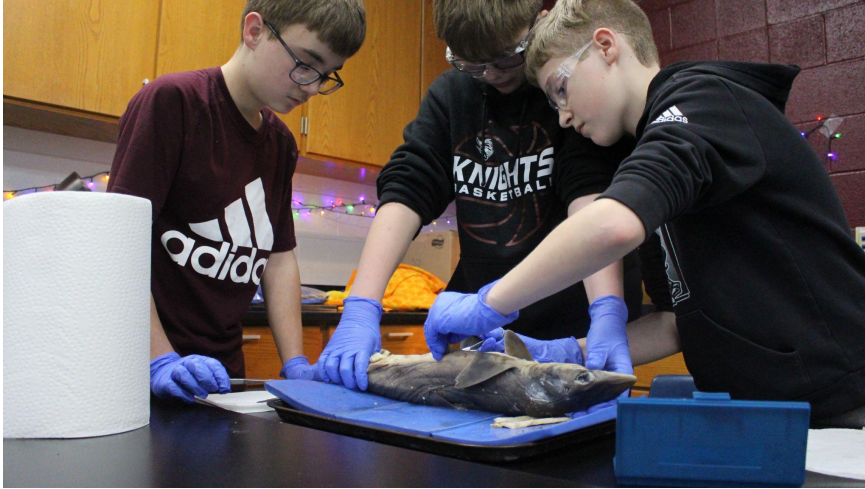

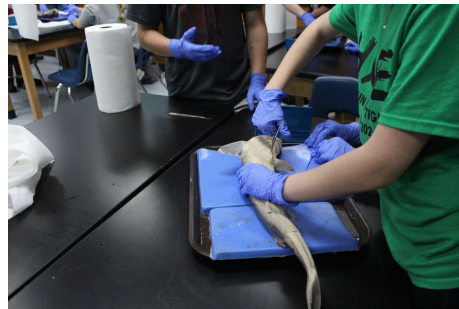

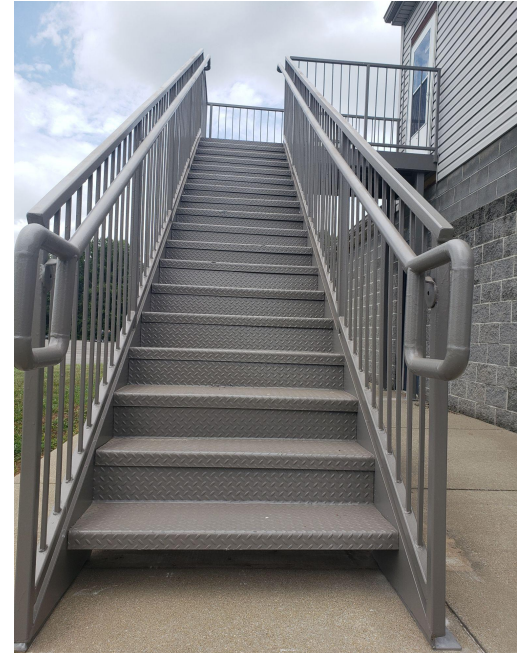
The football press box received new flooring, windows, and siding.
