Garrard County Schools Kentucky School for the Deaf Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding is made and entered into this **December 10, 2024** by and between the Garrard County Board of Education located and the Kentucky Department of Education on behalf of the Kentucky School for the Deaf (KSD) located in Danville, Kentucky. Subject to the terms and conditions set out in this MOU, and in consideration of the mutual exchange of services, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Garrard County Schools shall provide classroom instruction for Kentucky School for the Deaf students attending classes in Garrard County Schools.
- 2. The Kentucky School for the Deaf shall provide interpreter services for KSD students attending classes in Garrard County Schools and provide all transportation to KSD students attending classes in Garrard County Schools. To the extent Chromebooks are needed for class participation in Garrard County Schools, KSD will provide the same to KSD students.
- 3. This MOU will be considered an on-going agreement, and it will renew automatically every school year pending availability of spaces in the classroom.
- 4. It is mutually agreed by and between the Garrard County Board of Education and the Kentucky School for the Deaf that either party may terminate this contract by giving the other party at least two (2) weeks written notice.
- 5. **Confidentiality:** Subject to sub-clause (2) below, each party and its employees shall treat as strictly confidential all data or information received or obtained as a result of entering into or performing this Agreement, including any data or information protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 ("FERPA"), as amended, and its regulations, the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1751 et seq.)("NSLA"), the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1771 et seq.)("CAN"), or the Kentucky Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (KRS 160.700, et seq.)("KY FERPA").

Each party may	disclose information	which would	otherwise be	confidential is	f and to the
extent:					

(1) Required by the law of any relevant jurisdiction.

(2) The other party has given prior written approval to the disclosure, provided that any such information disclosed shall be disclosed only after consultation with and notice to the other party.
