Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to name the green space at 350 Reed Lane across from Lafayette High School, "Dwight Price Lawn."

Background/Rationale: Board policy 05.1 outlines the naming of school buildings and associated facilities are the responsibility of the Board of Education. Names may come from prominent state, local, or national figures of good character; prominent persons who have contributed to the history and/or progress of the Lexington/Fayette County area; community leaders, former board members, retired school leaders and/or teachers; donors of school property; geographic areas; and descriptive names that align with the mission or learning culture of the school. Mr. Dwight L. Price, a retired employee, served Fayette County Public Schools as a teacher, guidance counselor, associate principal, principal, and area superintendent. His stellar career impacted thousands of children and is outlined in the attached timeline.
