By 2027 Stanton Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in:

- Reading from 41% (2024) to 51%.
- Math from 35% (2024) to 45%
- Science from 24% (2024) to 40%
- Social Studies for Elementary from 22% (2024) to 40%,
- Combined Writing/Editing and Mechanics for Elementary from 22% (2024) to 40%

By 2027 Stanton Elementary will increase:

- Climate index from 78.4 to 83.4
- Safety index from 71.1 to 76.1
