Grant Details

The Ag Innovation Grant is designed to help local Agricultural Education programs transform student instruction and outreach to the community. To be approved applications must demonstrate the proposed project will positively impact student achievement and the local agriculture economy. Ag Programs may apply up to \$10,000. Applications do not require a match, but preference will be given to applications that include additional local funds.

Powell County Application Details

Powell County will be applying for funds to be used toward the purchase of Livestock Panels. The Powell County FFA Chapter hosts various petting zoos for our school events and has to borrow these panels when hosting such events. In addition, the Powell County Extention Office previously hosted Farm Day for our community but no longer does so. The FFA Chapter plans to serve as the primary sponsor for this community/school Event moving forward. Having our own panels will be an asset to the FFA Program.

Match Funding

There is no funding match needed from the district. Any additional cost for the panels that the grant funds do not cover will be the responsibility of the FFA Chapter.
