
Comparison Year: 12-mo ending Nov 2008 (TFMS = 12-mo ending Nov 2011)



Key takeaways this month:

- 1. Seven schools show an increase in ENERGY STAR Scores compared to previous month.
- 2. Focus on unoccupied baseline usage continues to result in electricity decrease compared to last year.
- 3. Reductions in electrical usage over Winter Break resulted in an approximate savings of over \$4,000 compared to last year. There is still opportunity for further reductions and this will continue to be a priority for future breaks.






Moving from Monthly Billing Data to 15-minute Interval Data
