**Honor Roll** - We had 87 total students on the Honor/Super Honor Roll for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of school from 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grades. To celebrate this big accomplishment, students will receive an in-school pizza and movie party.

**Book Fairs** - The Scripps Howard Foundation gifted Scholastic Book Fair will be held this upcoming week of January 27, 2025. EACH student in grades preschool through 6<sup>th</sup> grade will receive FIVE student selected books. The second book fair will be gifted this April.

**Benchmark Assessments** – Our students completed their AIMSweb and STAR assessments in December before their winter break. We are very pleased with the students’ growth progress and have used this important winter data to create our new WIN (“What I Need”) groups that have begun. These groups are created to meet students’ academic needs. Each grade level’s 7-10 WIN groups consist of groups for Gifted and Talented, on grade level and also intervention.

**School Play** – Auditions have been held for our spring production of *Alice in Wonderland* and practice has begun. The play will be held the weekend of March 20<sup>th</sup> – March 22<sup>nd</sup>. We are so excited for this opportunity for our students! Our new stage curtains have been installed and look absolutely beautiful. The students in the drama club have been enjoying outside arts opportunities seeing plays at other theatre houses. This is made possible with the *Roseann Sharon Fine Arts Fund*.
