A. The mission at Franklin Elementary School is to provide a learning environment that will enable each child to reach his/her own potential. By witnessing a live performance of the story adaptation "Pan!", which will allow students to fall into the world of Peter Pan and meet characters such as Nana the dog, Peter Pan, Tinkerbell, and so many more. Students will be able to see an actual fairy tale story come to life which is a unit of study they have learned about this year. They will also make SEL connections to common themes such as making friends and accepting people's differences. This will help our kindergartners have experiences that will aid in reaching each student's potential. On March 20, 2025, BGOnStage will perform "Pan!" at SKYPAC in Bowling Green, KY. We partnered with the organization, Arts of Southern Kentucky, to receive discounted rates of \$7 per student with 1 free adult per 10 students. FES Kindergartners and their chaperones will leave school and travel by bus to Bowling Green, KY around 11am and be seated at SKYPAC by 12:00p start time. Immediately following the performance, students will walk across the street to Circus Square Park for a short play time. We should return back to school by no later than 2pm. At this time, teachers will make connections to review unit 2 classic story elements. Specifically, connections will be made to the story elements of character, setting, problem, and solution. Connections to SEL and the theme of a story will also be made and discussed, such as friendships and kindness. This will also set the stage and provide schema for the upcoming unit about the earth's natural resources, including the ocean, and people's affects on our natural resources.

- Explicitly teach story structures of classic tales and fiction texts
- Explicitly teach SEL topics making friends and sharing

After March 29, 2024

- Prepare for Unit 11 Taking Care of the Earth. Make connections to Pan! and all the characters in the story.
- B. The outcome of this project will be the schema, vocabulary, and knowledge built throughout the project's timeline. There will be an assessment at the end of Unit 11. Students and teachers can be surveyed for the effectiveness of the project and timeline. Students will be able to express their new found knowledge and experiences through verbal, written, and artistic communication.

C. BUDGET

As stated, we partnered with Arts of Southern Kentucky to receive a discounted rate for the student tickets and free tickets for a limited number of staff. Attached are quotes from Simpson County Schools Bus Transportation and Arts of Southern Kentucky's quote for tickets.

SCS Bus Quote that includes all costs associated is around \$1,250. The ASK quote for tickets that includes all costs is \$2,000. FES is asking the FSEEF to cover the cost of the tickets and transportation at a grand total of \$3,250.

D. The mission of the Franklin Simpson Educational Excellence Foundation, Inc. is "to supplement existing educational opportunities through funding to educators and community organizations in order to facilitate effective learning." This educational experience will supplement the implementation of a newly adopted curriculum CKLA Amplify that addresses not only the latest research in Science of Reading but also provides a knowledge building component that incorporates science and social studies standards and concepts. Those who know kindergarten aged students know that they must have concrete and hands-on learning experiences. Some of the students, being that 65% of our population is free/reduced lunch, may

have never viewed a live performance outside of an opportunity such as this one. By helping teachers build schema and engaging students with a theatrical performance, students will experience language arts education at a much higher level, and may even heighten their love of language and the arts. FES simply can't wait to see our students' faces in awe of such a beautiful theater as the story they love comes to life!
