Background/Rationale: Schools focus their improvement efforts through the collaborative development of a Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP). This involves all stakeholders to review, revise and communicate a purpose for student success, establish and address priority needs, plan for the usage of District funds, and develop action plans to close achievement gaps between various student groups. This plan describes the specific goals and activities that build capacity for high-quality planning to address targeted needs to achieve the goals established by the state-mandated accountability system. The primary purposes of the CSIP include: to improve student achievement on state and federal mandated testing/accountability instruments; and, to eliminate achievement gaps among various student groups. The school's plan for eliminating achievement gaps among various groups of students is presented and approved by the School Based Decision Making Council by December and to the Board annually for its review and comment. The Comprehensive District Improvement Plan (CDIP) was approved by the Board in December 2024.
