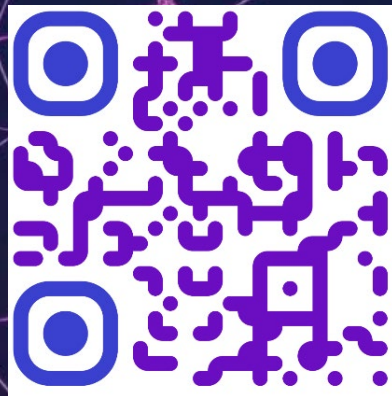

In response to the 2021 recommendations by the Commonwealth Education Continuum, the team set out to ...

- Create a comprehensive communications strategy to better equip high school students with the necessary knowledge to successfully transition to postsecondary.
- Catalyze a statewide, cross-agency campaign to improve FAFSA completion rates and access to FAFSA data for schools and districts.
- Strengthen local and regional partnerships among high schools, institutions, and the workforce to expand access, advising, and support to early postsecondary opportunities.

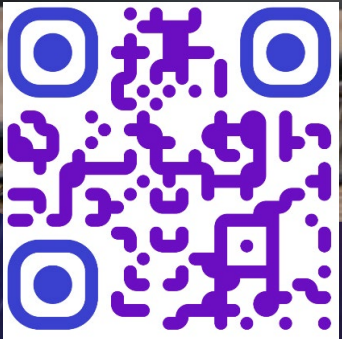
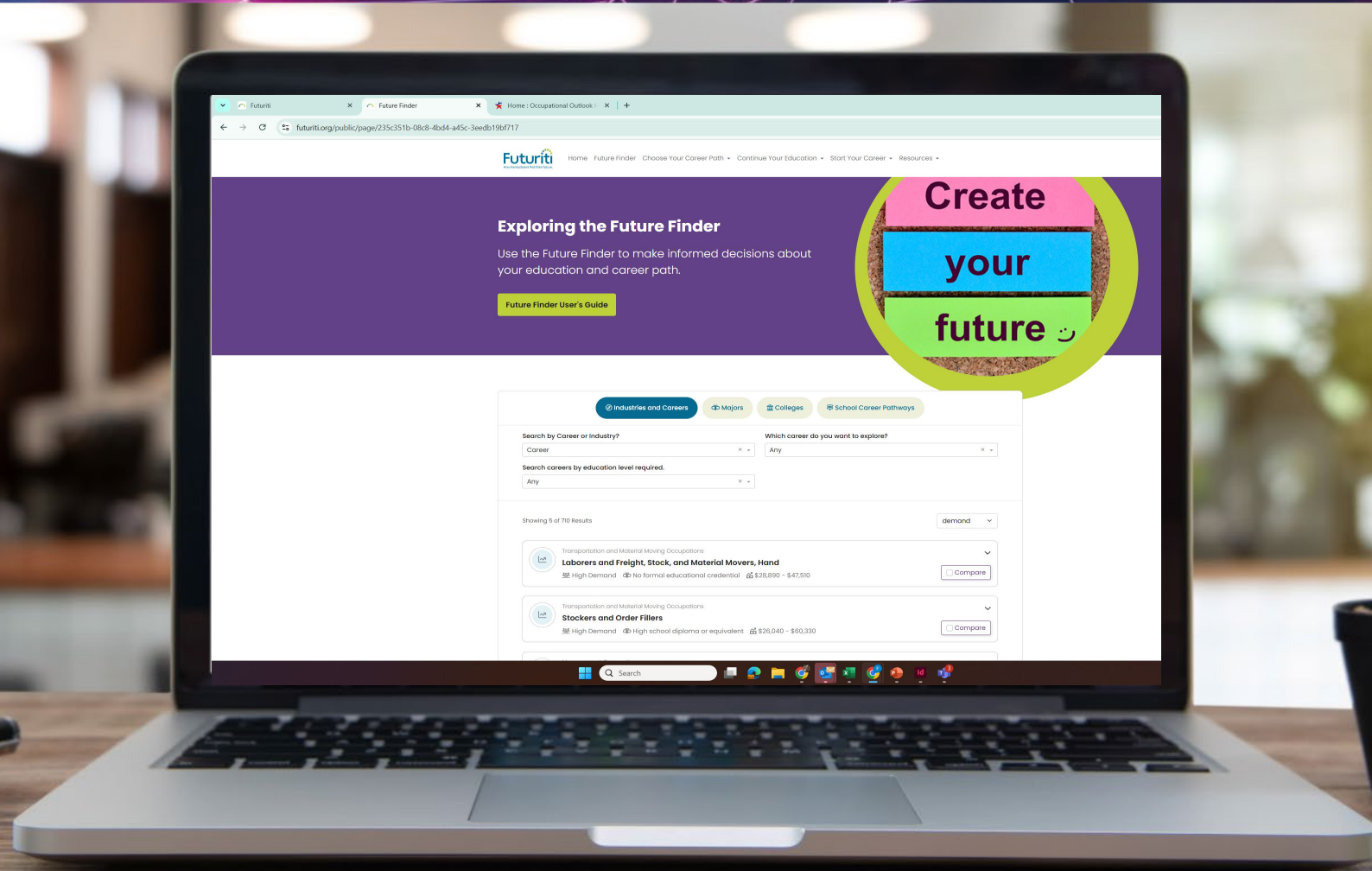

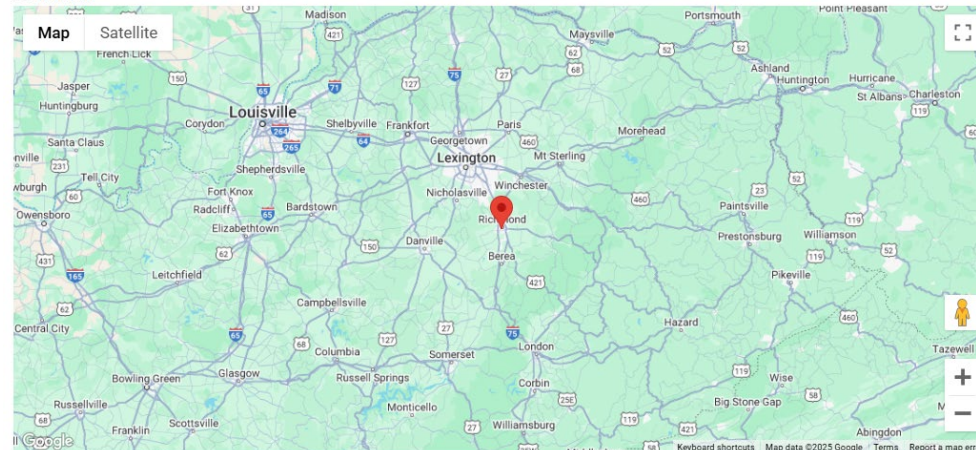

Enhance policies and regulations, in collaboration with the Education Professional Standards Board (EPSB) and Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE), to strengthen the teacher pipeline. Prioritize the recruitment and retention of teachers of color to increase the diversity of Kentucky's educators, enriching the educational environment for all students.

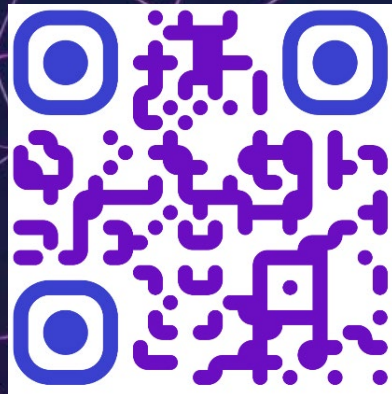
