We want the children in Simpson County to have the opportunity to be exposed to books at an early age to potentially raise literacy rates in the future. Simpson County currently has 23% of adults reading at or below a third grade level. Per 2023 KY Stats Early Childhood profile, 45% of children were ready for kindergarten and 55.5% of 3rd graders were reading at a proficient level in Simpson County. To increase literacy rates, the existence of an effective primary education system and other programs are necessary to enable a large part of the population to acquire the written word in daily life. Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is one of those amazing programs that helps place books in the hands of children. Any child from birth to 5 years of age, at no cost to the participant, is eligible to receive this wonderful opportunity. Dolly Parton founded Imagination Library as a tribute to her father who was illiterate. Dolly states that her dream is for every child to grow up in a home full of books. This organization gives 1 book a month to over 36 million children around the world. In Simpson County there are approximately 1,200 eligible children to receive this program. To date, have graduated 1,855 participants from the program. The cost for this program is \$2.60 per book or \$31.20 a year per child. We have been so incredibly fortunate to have generous sponsors to help fund this program throughout the years: Franklin Simpson Educational Excellence Foundation, Simpson County Schools, the Rotary Club of Simpson County, and the Community Early Childhood Council. Currently, there are 651 children in Simpson County enrolled. The cost to continue sponsoring them will be \$20,311.20 per year. We need to fundraise this amount to keep these kids receiving their monthly book. Registration is open for the remaining 549 eligible children. The chart below breaks down the current cost and the additional cost to be able to increase enrollment to all children in Simpson County.
