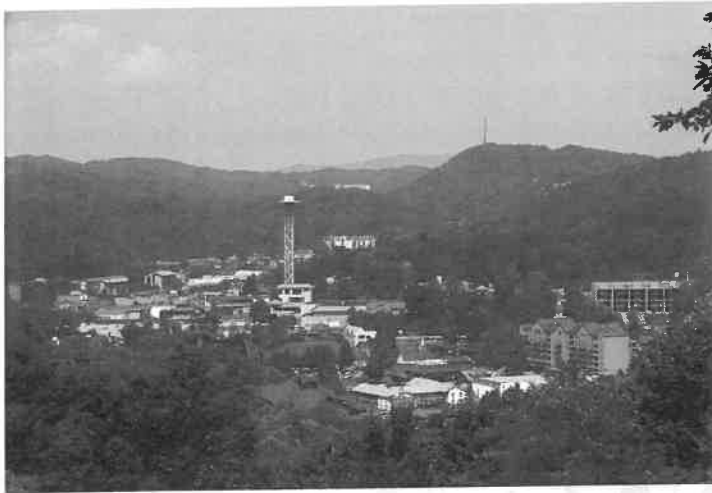

Travel/Dolly's Stampede

Meet at Webster County HS
