Meeting called to order at 3:49 PM by Chairperson Meyers

- 1. Opening Business
  - a. Approval of the Agenda
    - i. Motion to approve the agenda made by Mr. Fitzgerald, second by Ms. Bihr. No objections.
  - b. Approval of the December Minutes
    - i. Motion to approve the December minutes made by Mrs. Kohrs, second by Mr. Ratterman. No objections.
  - b. Good News Report
    - i. Mr. Meyers mentioned the success of Winter STAR testing.
    - ii. Mr. Meyers commented on the importance of Inspire Speaker from this morning. Students seemed to be very receptive, and teachers commented on how most students were intrigued and engaged with our Inspire Speaker.
    - iii. Homecoming is also on Saturday night, with a pep rally on Friday for the Homecoming Court and winter athletes.
    - iv. Attendance is slowly but surely improving after a tough few weeks of the semester because of the severe weather recently.
    - v. Mr. Meyers mentioned the effectiveness of the class meetings to start the semester.
  - c. Public Comment
    - i. No public comment.
- 2. Student Achievement Report/Data
  - a. Post-Secondary Rate
    - i. Mr. Meyers shared our students who are currently out of the building and their success in the first semester.
      - 1. 30 total students attend Gateway-out of the possible 60 credits to be earned, students earned 59 of them.

- 2. 12 total students attend NKU-out of the possible 64 credits to be earned, students earned all 64 credits of them with a majority of grades being 'As.'
- 3. 8 total students attend ATC at Campbell County High School-7 of the 8 students passed for the first semester.
- 4. 1 student currently attends Ignite-this student passed all 6 classes with 5 'As' and 1 'B.'
- ii. Mr. Meyers shared our 1<sup>st</sup> semester honor roll and super honor roll numbers. He separated it between the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter honor rolls to the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter honor rolls and noticed a significant decrease in numbers for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter honor rolls.
- iii. Mr. Meyers shared that our senior class is 84% post-secondary ready, 41% for juniors, and 19% for sophomores.

### b. Winter STAR Data

i. The committee reviewed the winter STAR data-seeing significant growth from Fall testing in all grades in both reading and math.

### 3. Budget Report

- a. Mr. Volpenhein requested that SBDM purchases a practice ACT from Torch Prep. It will give our junior students a real look at what the ACT is like before taking the state ACT on March 11<sup>th</sup>. The idea is to get students exposure to the test to better prepare them for the test. The price is \$9 per student, with a minimum of \$500. SBDM approved the purchase.
- b. Mr. Meyers read a letter from the librarian and Youth Services Coordinator requesting funds to support their Valentines book exchange. They are asking for \$450 to fund the program where students will receive a book to own. SBDM approved the purchase.

## 4. Committee Reports – English

- a. Mr. Fitzgerald shared STAR Reading data from the Winter. Items to note were that each grade level improved from Fall to Winter STAR testing.
- b. One issue that was brought to light was that it is tougher to get older students, juniors/seniors mostly, to test seriously, especially because many of those students are out of the building.
- c. Mr. Fitzgerald shared the English department's goals for KSA testing.

#### 5. New Business

- i. Dayton High School Council By-Laws
  - 1. The committee read through the first three pages of the DHS bylaws for review. All committee members approved and didn't see any issues.
