AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider/Approve awarding the KCS D Wireless and Switching Mini-Bid dated 02.18.2025 to SJN Data Center, LLC dba Encore Technologies for Fortinet Networking Equipment as part of the District's 10-year Technology Plan leveraging the E-Rate Program.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

Fiscal Management 04.32 AP.1

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The KCS D Technology Team forecasts District technology needs on a ten (10) year plan. To help offset costs associated with this plan, the District utilizes the E-Rate Program (Schools and Libraries Program of the Universal Service Fund, which is administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) under the direction of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC)). This is the final year of the 5-Year Category 2 E-Rate Funding Cycle, which provides the District with up to \$2,296,250 in available funds for eligible equipment and services. Since the District is only responsible for 20% of the available fund total, the maximum out of pocket investment is \$459,250. This amount is already budgeted into the Technology General Fund for the current fiscal year. This is the current Director of Technology's first opportunity to utilize the E-Rate program with his's team's 10-year plan. Following this plan calls for replacement of switches and access points that were purchased and installed by the previous Director of Technology. Some of the equipment due to be replaced is beyond useful life, as detailed on the attached table, and some of the items have not yet reached end of life. All replaced equipment will go through the District's surplus process. The proceeds of any items sold will go to the General Fund. To bring consistency, stability, and reliability to the District network over the next 10 year cycle, this request is for the replacement of core, top of stack, and edge switches as well as wireless access points. The Kentucky Department of Education establishes networking E-Rate contracts and the District can leverage these by conducting a mini-bid as part of the E-Rate process. The District sent out request for quotes on 2/5/2025 and received 10 quotes from 6 different vendors. SJN Data Center, LLC dba Encore Technologies with E-Rate SPIN number 143049494 provided an evaluated bid for Fortinet equipment, as show on the attached tabulation table. The cost to purchase this equipment is \$381,439.14 against the available \$459,250. The overall benefits with this 10-year plan include: a subscription-free management model saving the District nearly \$90,000 over the next 5 years, reduced long-term operational costs, alignment of manufacturer equipment for a seamless end user and management experience, an equitable and improved experience for all students and staff at each campus including the addition of NKYDC, speed increases up to 2.5 times faster than current network speeds and predictable, long-term future network replacement cycles.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

\$381,439.14 from the Technology General Fund. The Vendor (SJN) will contribute \$1,525,756.57 through the E-Rate program on the District's behalf for a total value of \$1,907,195.71.

RECOMMENDATION:
