My name is Amanda Higdon, and I am writing this letter to support the request for early graduation for Amarna "Ash" Higdon, senior at North Bullitt High School. This is the best option for Ash and will ensure their graduation from high school.

Over the last year, Ash has struggled with anxiety issues and other physical illnesses. These illnesses have caused issues with attendance and has affected their performance in school. If you look at Ash's transcripts, you will see that we had no prior issues with attendance, and their grades were consistently passing. During the spring semester of their junior year, Ash began experiencing consistent nausea and vomiting. This resulted in multiple days missed from school, poor performance and struggles in their classes. This ultimately resulted in failure of Algebra 2, and lower than normal grades in their other classes.

Ash started senior year, motivated and with a plan to take college courses through the dual credit program offered by JCTC, along with jumpstart classes offered by Sullivan University, that they began taking over the summer. However, a few weeks into this school year, Ash began experiencing migraines and soon after, consistent back pain. The back pain caused Ash to miss multiple days of school, and left me, as a parent concerned for their health and worried that Ash might not finish high school. During this time, we had a lot of tough conversations about what the best course for us would be, what the future would look like, along with how these decisions would affect their future plans. Dear Dr Bacon,

Thank you for gracing me with this amazing opportunity to put myself forward and into the real world sooner than later. When I learned I had a chance at graduating early so I no longer have to deal with all the issues surrounding having to attend school, I was super excited and jumped on the opportunity. I've had a rough year with various events that left a heavy impact on my mental health and anxiety like being left by my "best friend" of 6 years with no closure and dealing with the loss of a close friend as well. My year started rough because I was arrested and put on house arrest the previous months so my relationship with everyone around me was very rough which bled into this year. It was always back and forth and me being left in the dark and feeling horrible. Eventually when my mom attempted to leave me alone with my brothers in the discomfort of the place I had to call my home, I refused and packed up and left to my "best friends" house. My mother knew I was uncomfortable being left in the house alone with my attacker, especially since I have to walk through his room to get to mine. On top of that, she couldn't accommodate my birthday for her vacation every year but made sure to be there for everyone else. Everything was nice living with my friend until we started to argue more often and she began to leave me on read not wanting to resolve small issues which led to a big big gap in our friendship. This eventually ended our friendship and also ended with me trying to reach for closure but not getting Any. She asked me to leave knowing everything that has happened and how I lived in constant fear, because of this I then told her I was talking to her mom and would be sooner than later. At a loss, I bought a camper and texted her mom the situation while still living there in her room. I vowed then on to make my own money and support myself from then on because they will leave you high and dry. Her mom was gracious enough to give me all the time and money and supplies I needed to get me on my feet and I parked my camper in my backyard to move back in. I set up my camper and adjusted to life but I quickly realized the reason the camper was cheap in the first place. I realized it was probably unfit for 4 cats and me for the winter so I decided to figure out a way to go back in the house. My mom had been begging me to come back but I only did with the compromise I needed a new room and luckily my other brother was moving out into his girlfriends finally. As I moved back from my camper into the basement, my brother had attacked me only a day or 2 after I moved into his room causing me to feel connection or comfort in my new room. The sound of my door reminds me of how scared I used to be when he would come up the stairs, I would practically run to avoid interacting with him. After the second time being attacked and begging the police to take me away, I realized I have absolutely no one who will genuinely be by me or support me and feel genuine happiness for my successes as if they were their own. I really pushed myself into work and wanted to make more money but when I went to school I couldn't go to work due to extreme exhaustion so I had to call out a few times which cut some hours.

This aggravated my boss so he cut my hours drastically and I haven't been making the same money since. This honestly is like a domino effect on my mental health because I use my money to provide extra activities for my sense of fun and provide needs which I've been struggling with since starting school. I realized how much "luxury" items like face wash and frozen chicken tenders were really quick. More relative to my school year, everything has been light and easy but only because I stopped finding interest in anything to do with school or extra effort when I realized how easy it was to get through online school and also that school wasn't that "important" to me if I was dedicated to making money to move out and such. I had a job and I could work as early as they needed me til as late and the hours were nice and I was bringing in enough money to buy myself my needs for the month, my cats medicine, and make my credit card payments and still have a little bit extra to last me incase I wanted to do anything before the next 2 weeks. When all of this changed due to school I decided to stop coming and throw myself into work again so that I could make enough money. I stopped coming due to exhaustion, making money, and my unfortunate anxiety every morning. I would wake up sick to myself thinking about going to school, having to watch my every move around everyone because of how conscious I was of everyone and everything around me normally. Being online for so long I had a long time to sit around and overthink all kinds of possibilities of regular school. Once I realized my boss was keeping my hours cut, my anxiety was getting better, and I was being threatened with court which I knew would lead to my unfortunate arrest due to my previous charges, I knew I had to start turning up. So I eventually turned up and found my culinary class to be my inspiration but then Mrs. Burba approached me with a plan to go finish my 2 credits on edgenuity and graduate early. I found this to be the best option so I can move out once I graduate and be out of my toxic household that only drains and takes from me. I since then threw myself into my edgenuity and school work to finish and graduate early so I can thrive outside of school. I'm glad to be given this opportunity to throw myself into the "real" world sooner than later.

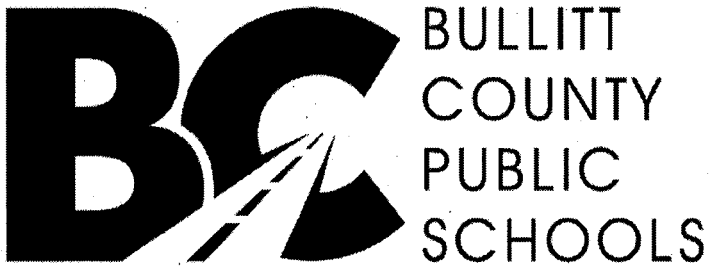


