Galt House Emergency Evacuation Protocol

Emergencies occur when we least expect them. It is important to be as prepared as possible when an emergency arises at one of our hotels. A well thought out emergency response is one of the cornerstones of The Al J. Schneider Company's safety program; we owe this to you and every one of our guests and associates.

In the event of a fire or other emergency, seconds count. The safe, orderly, and prompt evacuation of the hotel guests and associates is paramount. Emergency Response Planning can involve several incidents that require decisive and immediate action.... fire, weather, chemical spills, mechanical issues within our complex, and criminal attacks. Knowing what to do and how to do it is critical.

The number one priority is to remain calm.

All the AJS Hotels are equipped with the most technologically advanced fire detection systems, emergency service notification, fire suppression systems, and public address systems.

Know where to go.

All exits are clearly marked and illuminated. In the event of a power outage all AJS Hotels have emergency generators that will provide essential services in a power outage incident. The elevators will continue to operate unless there is an elevator lobby smoke alarm. Elevators may be used for evacuations for special needs, all others should use fire stairwells. If you are going to

require special assistance in emergency evacuations, please advise our hotel associate when registering.

Proceed to the nearest marked emergency exit.

Follow a route that takes you completely outside the facility. Locate and remain at a rally point. Once an emergency occurs, our staff will quickly assist guests in evacuations and lead them to a safe and secure location. Rally points for the Galt House Hotel are identified on the following page.

Rally Points:

Galt House, West Tower:

- #1- North Belvedere Deck (overlooking Ohio River)
- #2- South Belvedere deck (outside American Home Life building)

Galt House, Suites Tower

- #3- Bus Lot
- #4- YUM! Center front sidewalk

Each individual sleeping room has a floor diagram with stairwell exit points for that particular area.

During your stay, please familiarize yourself with the layout, hallways and emergency exits. This situational awareness may help facilitate your safe evacuation.
