Overview of Menifee County Schools English Learners: Lau Plan

- **Vision & Purpose:** Ensure every student transitions to a successful future. The EL program ("Lau Plan") provides English learners with equitable academic opportunities.
- **Enrollment & Identification:**
 - Home Language Survey at enrollment
 - WIDA screening determines EL status
 - Students scoring <4.5 on WIDA join the EL program
 - Program Service Plan (PSP) created for each EL student

Language Instruction (LIEP): Structured English Immersion with co-teaching or pull-out services, plus professional development for staff.

Equal Access: EL students participate in all academic and extracurricular programs with multiple evaluation indicators.

Assessment & Exit Criteria:

- Annual WIDA ACCESS test assesses language growth
- Students exit at a 4.5 composite score and enter a 4-year monitoring phase



Botts Early Learning Center

- Preschool spring childcount was submitted on March 1st with an increase of 1 state-funded preschool student.
- On May 9th, there will be a joint open enrollment for Preschool/Head Start at Botts for the 25/26 school year.
- 154 children enrolled in Imagination Library.

Wildcat Den Updates

- Wildcat Den updates:
 - Currently have 17 prospective full-time children and 14 part-time.
 - 10 infants and 7 between the ages of 1 and 2.
