- Kristy Crouch :
- Teachers have inventoried what they want to reorder for the Amplify 2nd edition and have been looking at the changes to the 3rd edition. We have been working with the Amplify rep to get quotes for both the 2nd and 3rd editions. Quotes were supposed

to be back last week, but the reps are backed up with the 2nd to 3rd edition rollouts. A quote is supposed to come this week, per last communication with the rep. A survey is ready to be sent to teachers once quotes come back in. A decision will be made in the next few weeks as to which edition we will be ordering based on teacher feedback and pricing.

- The biggest changes between the 2nd and 3rd:
 - **Biggest change is in the knowledge topics
 - **Skills edited and adjusted in K-2 with most current research
 - **But Knowledge is where you will really see the changes based on customer feedback. New units and some units taken away.
 - **Pacing streamlined across the grades; Each grade level = 165 days
 - **Auto scoring digital adjustments updated
 - **Writing is now embedded not a separate writing studio; updated to align with the science of writing
 - **Culminating research units in every grade
 - **Choice units for every grade, there are 2 choice units towards the end of the year.
 - Each grade level should decide which units to choose
 - Example: In K, unit 8 can either be about monarchs or about presidents and American symbols
