

“Give Me A Reason” drug test kits

The “Give Me A Reason” (GMAR) prevention initiative is a voluntary drug testing program designed as a way for our youth to avoid peer pressure by having a reason to say “no” to drug use. When confronted with drugs, this initiative will give youth an opportunity to say:

“I can’t use drugs, my parents drug test me!”

“Give Me A Reason” provides parents or caregivers with free saliva-based drug testing kits. The noninvasive test is then given in the privacy of your home, and results are available in approximately 10 minutes.
