Elementary staff has been in the process of reviewing the math curriculum. I seems as though Bridges will be the HQIR of choice. Ms. Gray has submitted a grant proposal, which will cover all costs associated with the HQIR purchase, if we are awarded.

Weekly instructional meetings continue to occur in both buildings, seeking to identify plus-deltas that can be used to promote growth in each building.
