 - iii. A group of junior and freshmen students took a practice ACT in preparation for the real, state-wide ACT on Tuesday, March 11th.
 - iv. Mrs. Kohrs brought up the fantastic sophomore field trip to the ATC and Gateway. It sparked a lot of interest for students and the opportunities ahead of them as upperclassmen.
 - v. The 8th grade class of Southgate Elementary visited Dayton High School for an informative presentation and tour of the school. It seemed many of the Southgate students enjoyed themselves and were considering attending Dayton for high school.
 - vi. Mr. Ratterman shared his experience at EdCamp last Saturday where he shared the success of our Energy Bus program, especially the improvement in both attendance and behavior.
 - vii. Mr. Meyers shared the amazing news that Mr. Bird received a Golden Apple Award.
 - viii. The senior trip to Perfect North went really well-the students seemed to really enjoy it.

- 2. Student Achievement Report/Data
 - a. Post-Secondary Rate
 - i. 87% of senior class is Post-Secondary Ready
 - ii. 50% of junior class is Post-Secondary Ready
 - iii. 19% of sophomore class is Post-Secondary Ready
 - b. Graduation Rate Update Class of 2025
 - i. Mr. Meyers updated that we are keeping a close eye on all seniors and their graduation chances. There are a few seniors who are in potential danger but have been working on getting back on track.
 - ii. Mr. Meyers pointed out we will get one student who will be receiving an alternative diploma.
- 3. Budget Report
 - a. Council members had no questions about this month's budget report.
- 4. Committee Reports Math
 - a. Mr. Bird and the Math Department shared their Winter Report for math development. It outlines the students who are currently novice, apprentice, proficient, and distinguished in their math courses.
 - b. Highlights
 - i. 10th grade experienced higher growth than national average
 - ii. 58% of 10th graders are considered Proficient
 - iii. 65% of 11th graders are considered Proficient
 - iv. 58% of all HS students are considered Proficient
 - c. Areas of Concern
 - i. Grade 8 has the lowest level of Proficiency-only 42%
 - ii. All grade levels are below grade level
 - iii. Only 11th graders scored at or above the national average
