**AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):**

Consider/Approve a building and grounds alteration request at Piner Elementary for the update of a water feature being added to the courtyard area.

**APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:**

5.11 - Alterations of Buildings and Grounds

**HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

The Piner Elementary School eWise Club proposes to purchase and install a solar-powered water feature on the back wall of the courtyard. This feature will enhance the courtyard's aesthetics and educational value, providing a visually engaging and interactive element while allowing the eWise team to apply their knowledge of solar power in a practical setting. Safety will be prioritized by placing the feature against the wall to limit access, using slip-resistant materials, and implementing supervision measures while the courtyard is in use to minimize potential hazards. The Building Operations and District Maintenance teams will oversee and inspect the project to ensure all standards are met. The District's Operations team has reviewed and approved this request for Board consideration.
