History/Background:

Existing Policy: The applicant must meet a minimum GPA requirement and must have either a major in the academic area or passing score on the academic content assessment. The applicant must also have a job offer in the academic area for which certification is requested in a Kentucky school district.

Summary: Barren County Public Schools has submitted the CA-265 application and portfolio for Daniel Pike. The district is requesting that the EPSB approve his application for certification in the area of **Secondary English**, **Grades 8-12.** The application and portfolio are included under separate cover.
