- Celebrate the rich history of the East End of Lexington, the community in which LTMS is located.
- Restore pride in LTMS as a vital, positive and storied part of this community.

What We'll Share

- Names for a school will be recommended according to [board policy 05.1](#).

- Recommendations to the board by Mar 30, 2025

Key Messaging

- The recommendation for board approval will be April 17, 2025.
- The community will have the opportunity to submit names for consideration at various community forums and through an online link.
- Students, staff and families will narrow the suggestions down to three by voting the first week of March.
- Students present research on the finalists during a showcase-style event held **March 18, 2025**.
- SBDM will then vote to decide a name to submit for board approval.
