I am hoping the Soccer Rules Committee will consider the following change to future soccer games in the regular season:

**CHANGE**

Effective for all regular season boys' and girls' soccer games, in the event of a tie at the end of a regulation match, the teams shall participate in a shoot-out to determine the outcome. No other overtime periods shall apply in the regular season. For postseason events, the current NFHS rules governing Overtime shall continue to apply.

**RATIONALE**
