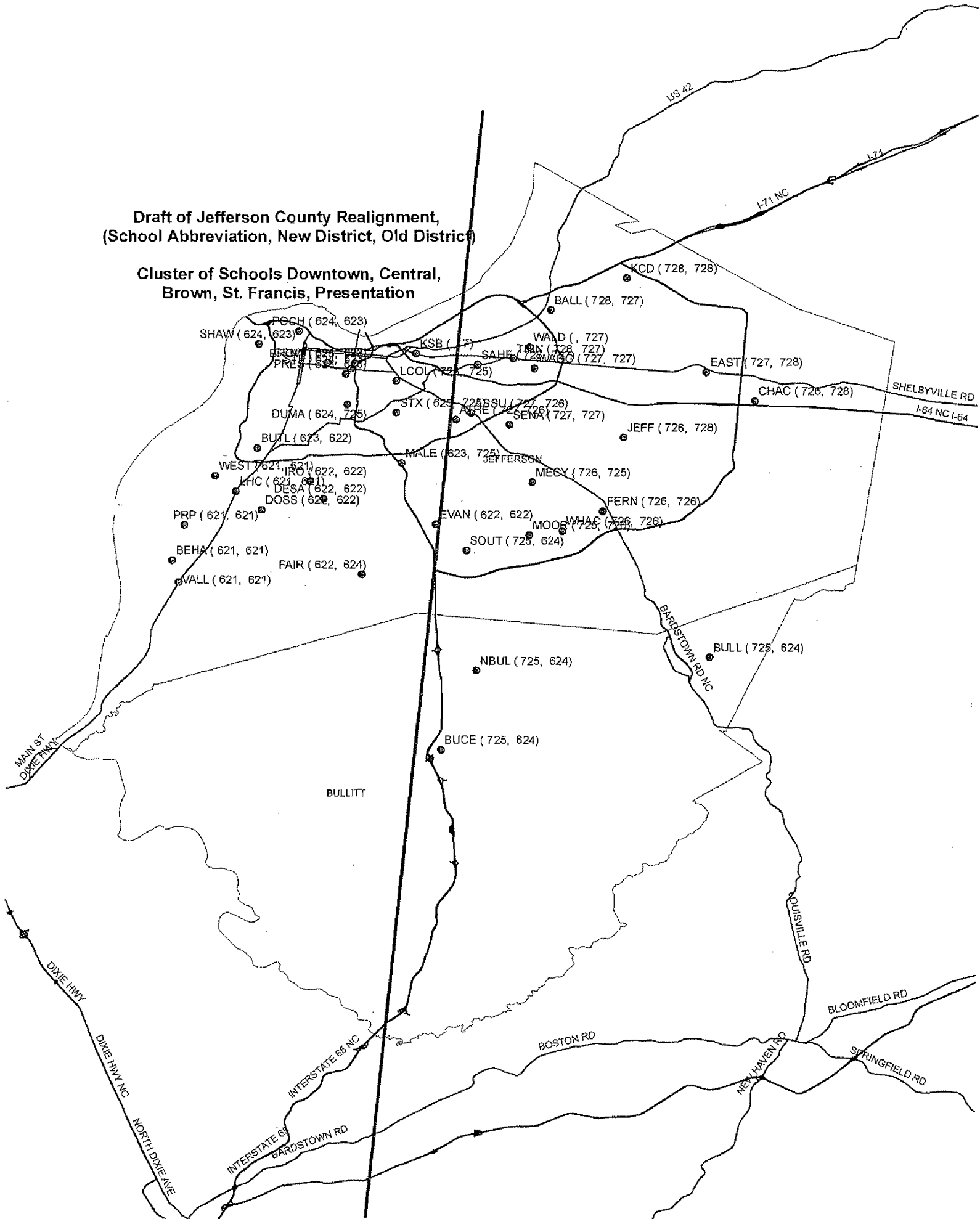

Board Members:

As principal of the J. Graham Brown School, Jefferson County, I feel a duty to express my serious concerns over the proposed alignment of 6th and 7th regions as recommended by the Policy Board of the Metro Area Athletic Directors. Under this proposal, District 23 will consist of five schools: Brown, Butler, Male, Presentation, and St. Xavier. Brown has a much smaller student body than any of the other schools in this district, even smaller than Presentation. Needless to say, such a district configuration will make it impossible for Brown to have any chance at competitiveness with peer schools in district play. On the other hand, District 24 will consist of Central, Manual, Portland Christian, St. Francis, and Shawnee. Within that district are two schools (Portland Christian and St. Francis,) with athletic programs that are similar to Brown in student enrollment and participation. This, coupled with Shawnee, makes for a district that allows for a degree of competitiveness between small schools, in spite of the inclusion of Manual and Central in that district.

It would appear that a more equitable alignment would consider placing the very small schools with one another in one district. Small schools with a very limited number of students could find themselves in a more competitive environment in which to play. A district consisting of Brown, St. Francis, Portland Christian, and Presentation would provide a more competitive balance for all of those schools.

I understand fully that achieving a balanced distribution of schools in district and regional alignments is very difficult to achieve. I also understand that it is impossible to please every school and make every situation work to every member's advantage. And I understand that the chances of a re-consideration of this alignment are very slim. However, as principal of one very small school that struggles to compete, I felt it necessary for me to voice our concerns about how this alignment, as proposed, will impact the J. Graham Brown School.

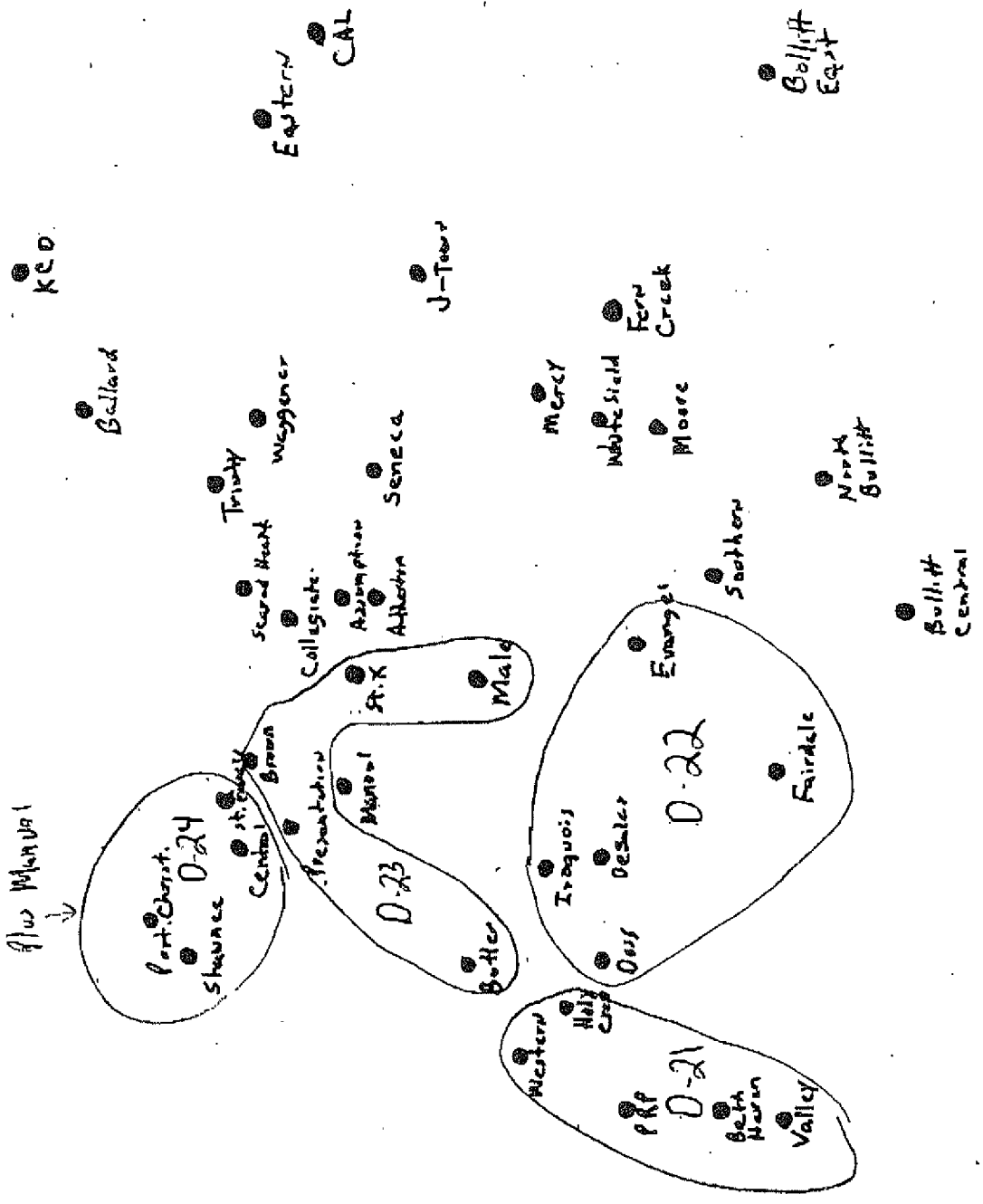

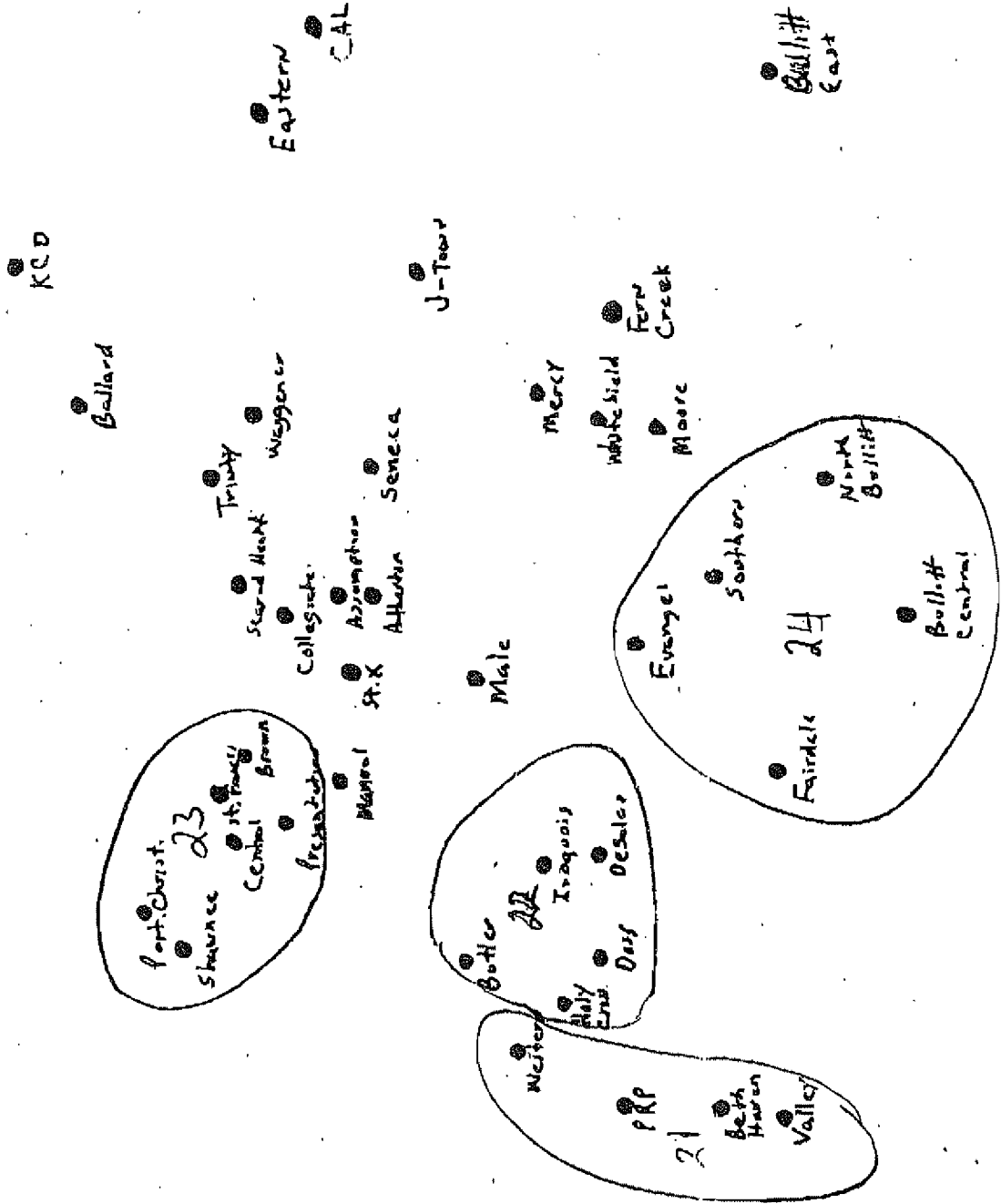
7th Region

Dear Mr. Tackett:

I am writing this letter to you in reference to the realignment proposal set by the Metro Area Athletic Directors Association here in Louisville. Butler Traditional High School does not agree with the proposal that was sent to the KHSAA by Jerry Wyman.

Our first issue is that the realignment proposal was devised by the Policy Board of our association. Butler HS feels it is not the policy board's responsibility to handle realignment issues. The duties of the policy board should be dealing with policies and rules. The different proposals were not presented to all the AD's before hand to be discussed and then select one from the different options. The athletic directors were basically told this is the proposal that is going to be turned in whether you disagree with it or not. I was personally told that I could not attend the meeting by which a proposal was decided.

Another issue is the balance by which the proposal does not achieve. Bringing Manual, St. Xavier, and Male to the 6th region means that there are 5 schools with large enough enrollment to be considered 6A (Butler, PRP, Manual, St X, and Male). The proposal turned in by Mr. Wyman has 3 of those schools in one district. One district would have Manual. Another District would have PRP and the fourth district would have no schools with 6A enrollment. The logical thing to do is to space these 5 larger schools throughout the four different districts. This would provide competitive balance with enrollment, and number of boys and girls sports offered.

Also, the proposal sent by the association might be geographic for some districts but definitely not ours. The 7th region districts run east-west geographically. Our proposed district runs both east-west and north-south. Three of the schools (Brown, Pres, and St X) in our proposed district would literally have to drive past Manual HS to get to Butler. Manual is closer to us than all of the schools that were selected to be in our district. For competitive balance the solution would be to take two of the larger schools and place them in one district and the remaining four districts would have one each.

District 27 is along Bardstown Rd

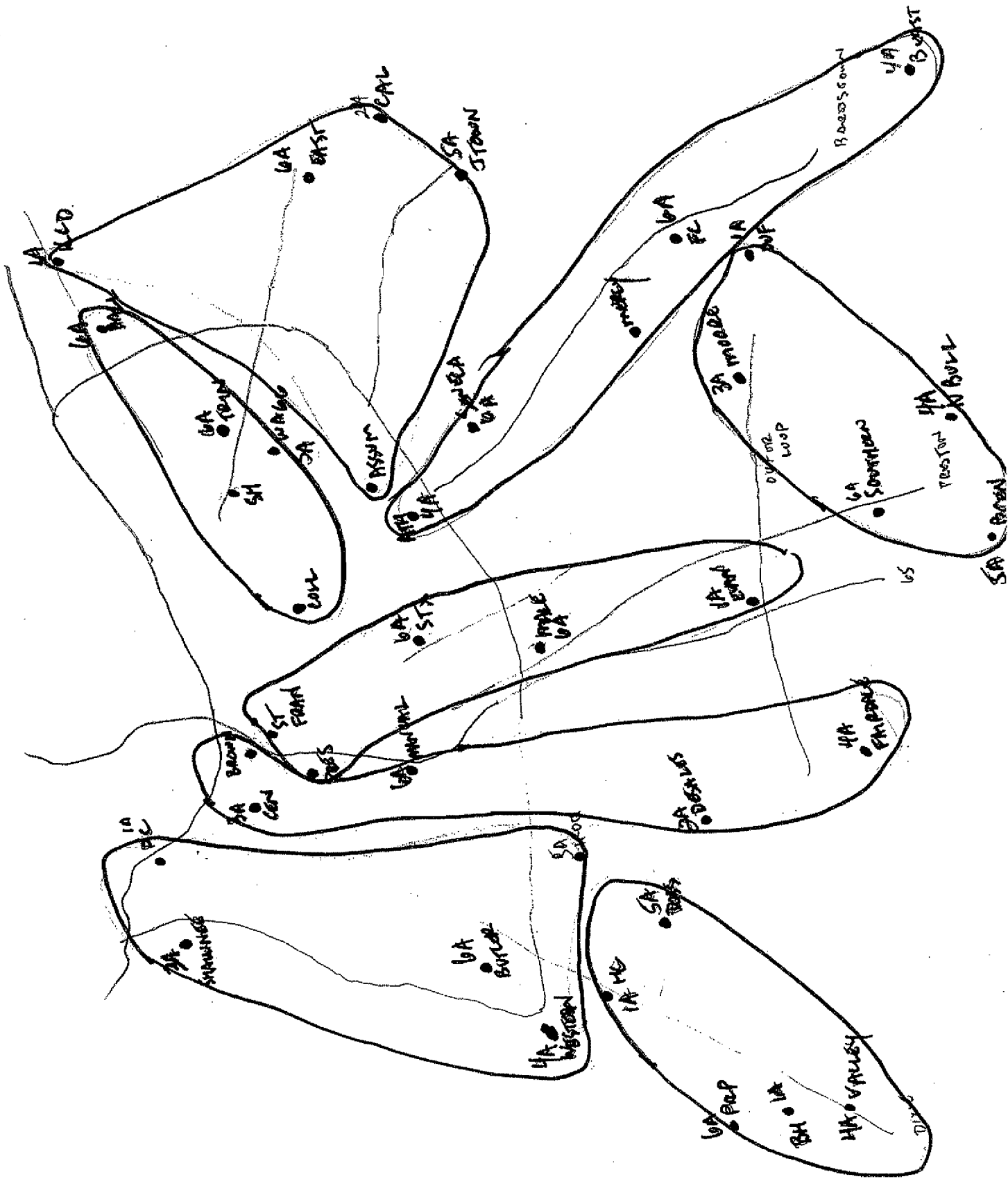

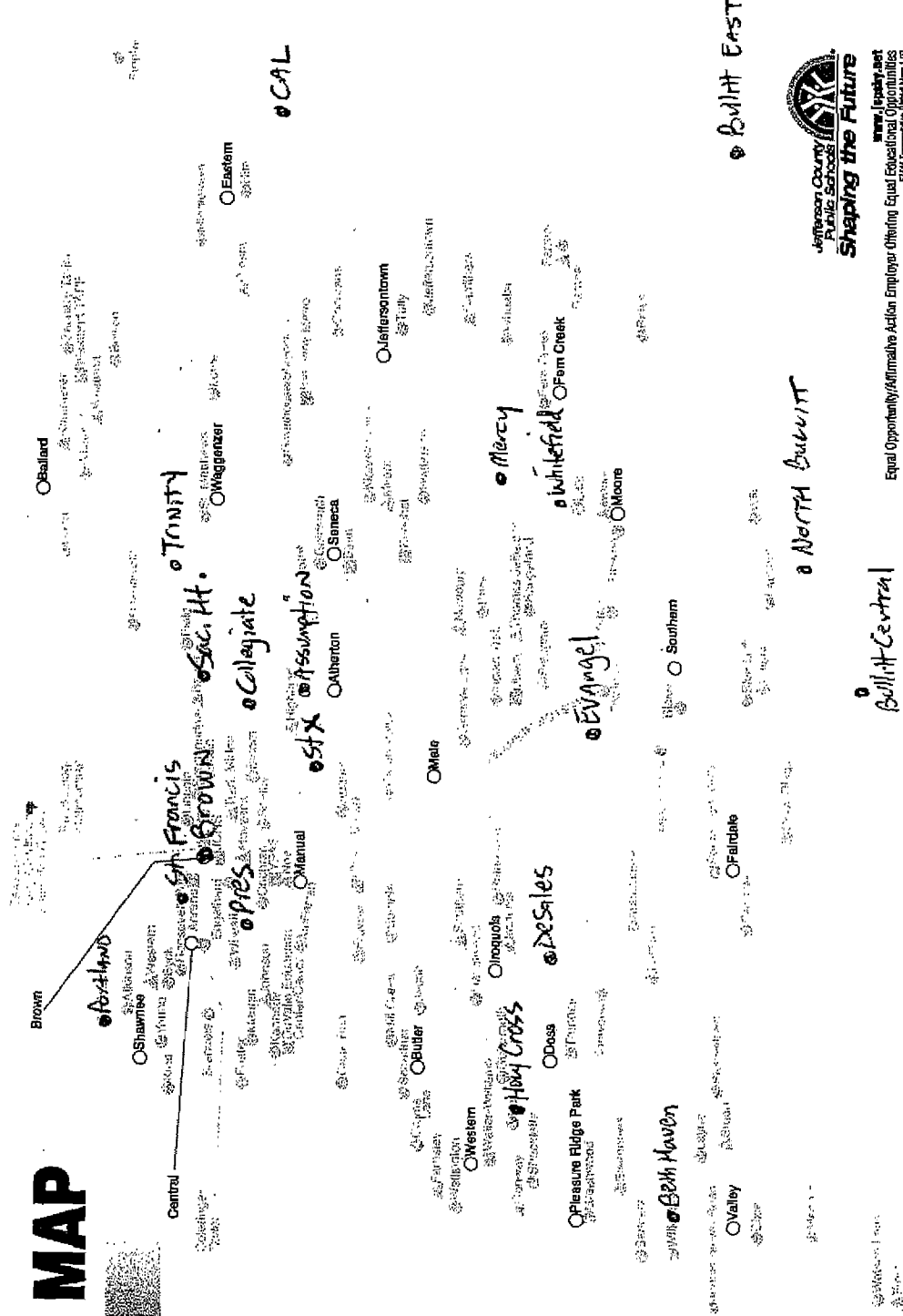

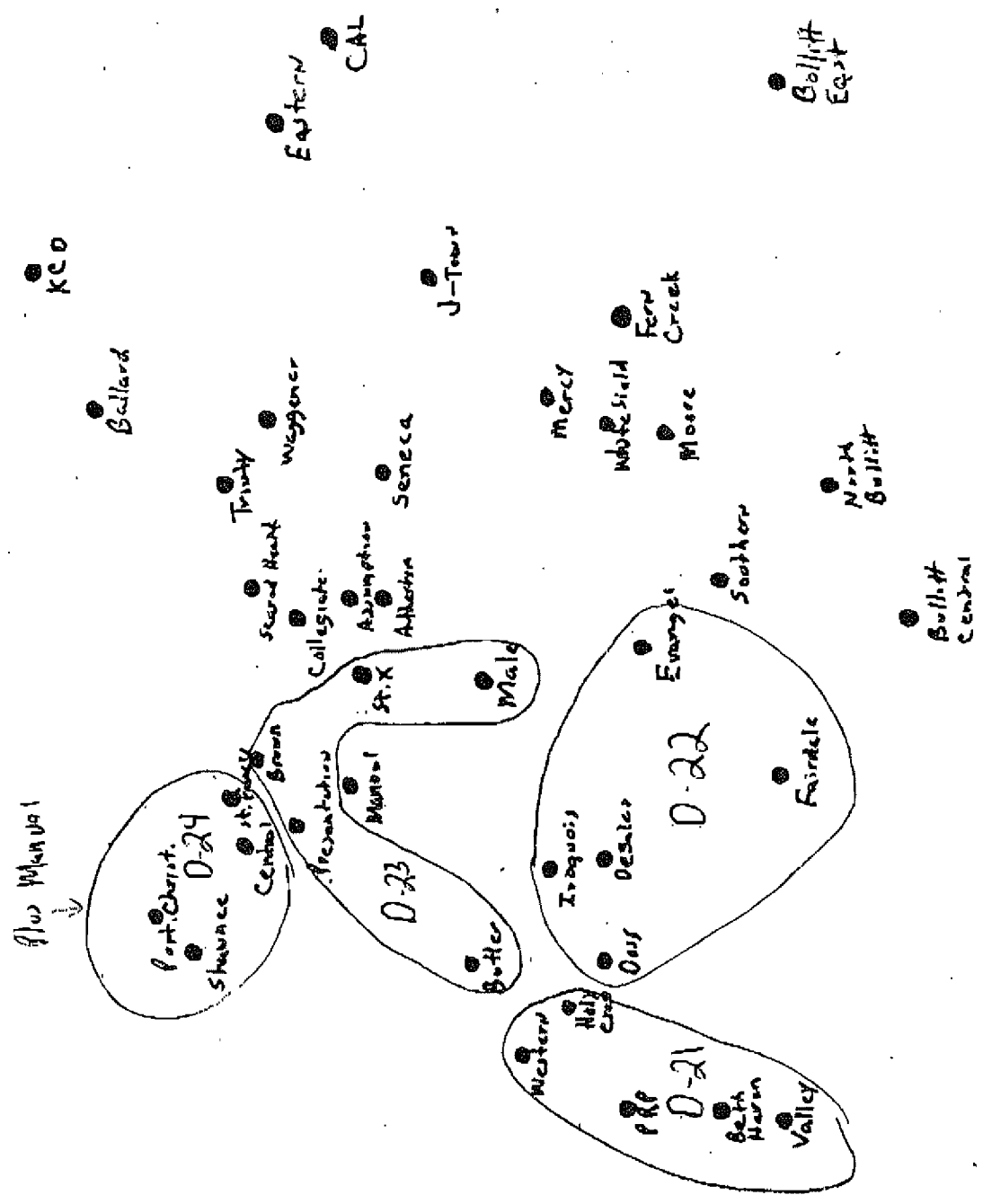
