Program Highlights

- In total, the Family Resource Center has had 12,247 student contacts and 3,385 parent contacts for the 24-25 school year thus far.
- Some of the programs provided include:

• Health Programs:

- Hygiene and Health Programs provided by Todd County Extension and Todd County Health Department to 3rd-5th grades
- Substance Abuse Prevention to include Cyber Safety Education, Tobacco and Vaping Prevention, a Character Development Program provided by Remix Education, and information to parents regarding education on these topics, as well.
- Through the School Smiles program, 371 students have been provided on-site dental care. An additional 71 medical-related student contacts were made to include hearing screenings and vision screenings/assistance.

• Family Literacy:

- School Family Literacy Nights and Events and in-school Literacy Programs, for students, in partnership with the schools to serve a total of 578 students
- On Presidents Day, FRYSC partnered with Todd County Extension to provide a Grandparents as Parents program to include a meal, craft, and giveaways to all 9 students/6 families
- Career Days were provided to K-5 students at both schools
- Academic support to include school supplies, participation in the schools' PBIS programs, attendance support and more was provided at 775 student contacts.

After-School and Summer Programming:

- 4-H Creative Arts and Cloverbud afterschool programs reached 63 students
- 63 students were served through summer/non-school day programs in partnership with Todd County Extension and Todd County 4-H.
- Additionally, we were able to assist 12 students in participating in extracurricular activities (park leagues, jr. pro, etc.)

• Families In Training & Pre-School Child Care:

- We had 21 moms in attendance at our annual community baby shower (partnership with TC Extension and TCHD)
- 73 preschool screenings have been conducted and 90 students have participated in Preschool Family Nights.

• Basic Needs and Holiday Assistance to include 822 student contacts

■ These programs would not be possible without community partnerships and sponsors.

- Happy Feet served 71 students with new shoes in August. The Rotary club continues partnering with FRYSC to provide new shoes to students in need at the start of the school year.
- Community members adopted 189 students to provide Christmas presents and 70 students with back to school clothes. Community donations also made it possible to provide 28 students with Halloween Costumes and 19 families with Thanksgiving baskets.
- 90 students have been served with food assistance, 70 of those students have received weekly assistance through the Backpack Food Program. We are grateful for community sponsorships and the partnership with Todd County 4-H to continue making this program possible.
