**MAP Testing:** The students in grades K-8 completed the third and final round of MAP testing last week. We saw some excellent growth for our last testing session of the year, and I am including the percentages of students who scored at or above the grade level norm for the spring. I have also included the data shared at the January board meeting for comparison of how the students performed in each subject area from winter to spring.
