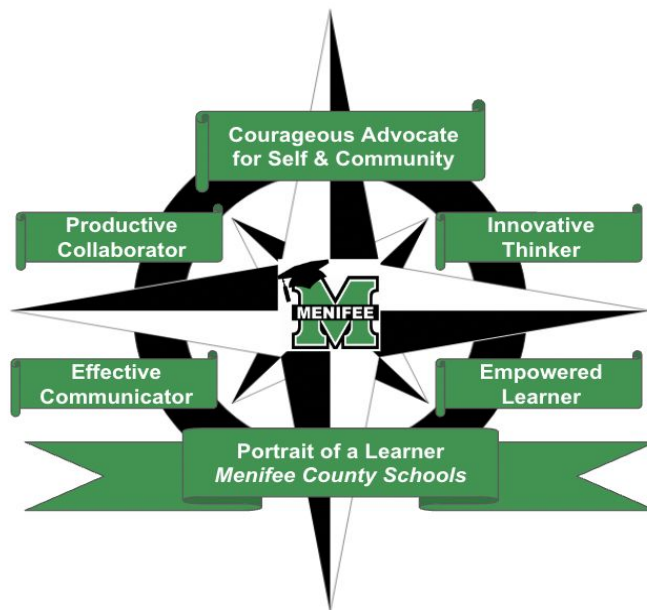




Principals' Report

Menifee Central Instruction/Monitoring

- The KYCL grant funded a virtual walkthroughs with Beth Comer and Ann Ganzert focused on whole-group Tier 1 instruction and provided feedback to participating teachers. The grant also funded Erika Perkins to model writing strategies in our 5th-grade ELA classroom.
